- 3. Copy of high school transcript indicating GPA.
- 4. ESSAY: "Advancing My Western Heritage Through Continuing Education and Career" (No less than 500 words)
- 5. Current color portrait of applicant (head shots preferred).

WESTERN LEGACY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP TERMS - Read and sign at the bottom of the page

- 1. Student must attend an accredited post-secondary institution. This includes trade and vocational schools.
- 2. The scholarship will be disbursed directly to the institution the student will be attending.
- 3. If the student withdraws from school during the time for which a refund is due, the refund will be prorated back to the scholarship fund of the Western Legacy Foundation.
- 4. Failure to meet requirements during the scholarship time period means that the scholarship will be revoked.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Academic (grades) 25 possible points
- 2. School involvement (extra-curricular, honors, etc.) 20 possible points
- 3. Community involvement (church, volunteerism, employment, etc.) 20 possible points
- 4. Essay 30 possible points
- 5. Presentation of application 5 possible points

Renewal of Category I and Rypkema Memorial Scholarships

The Western Legacy Foundation renewable scholarships can be renewed one time if the student meets the following criteria.

- 1. Student must have completed two semesters as a full-time student of an accredited post-secondary school.
- 2. Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 3. Student must submit original college transcript with classes completed.
- 4. Proof of full-time student status for the renewal year according to school criteria.

The second year's scholarship award (renewal) will be awarded the first semester of the second year. It is not necessary to fill out the application again. The above required documentation must be mailed or emailed to Brandy at Casey Peterson (accountant).
